Beginning today, individuals (faculty, staff and students) may apply for a parking decal online at [www.ccm.edu](http://www.ccm.edu). Once you are on the website go to Quicklinks and click on Public Safety.

There you will find our CCM Motor Vehicle Registration link. Simply click the link and complete the application form for motor vehicle registration. Here's a [shortcut link](#).

To obtain your decal, you will need to make a brief visit to the Public Safety Department located at 675 Route 10 East. You can park in Parking Lot 10. Please bring your college ID and your motor vehicle registration cards for verification. Once the information is verified a decal will be issued for your vehicle which will include a copy of our motor vehicles rules and regulations.
