National Stalking Awareness Month

In January 2004, the National Center for Victims of Crime launched National Stalking Awareness Month (NSAM) to increase the public's understanding of the crime of stalking. NSAM emerged from the work of the Stalking Resource Center, a national program funded by the Office on Violence Against Women, U.S. Department of Justice, to raise awareness about stalking and help develop and implement multidisciplinary responses to the crime.

NSAM and the Stalking Resource Center (SRC) of the National Center for Victims of Crime has continued its partnership with the Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) to bring resources and general awareness to the public about this important issue via their website dedicated to NSAM. the 14th annual observance of NSAM, which began in response to murdered stalking victim Peggy Klinke.

A working definition of stalking is a course of conduct, or pattern of behavior, directed at a specific person that would cause a reasonable person to feel fear. In the United States, 7.5 million people are stalked each year and the majority of victims are stalked by someone they know. Approximately half of all victims of stalking indicated that they were stalked before the age of 25.

The NSAM website contains downloadable resources to help educational institutions, organizations and other interested groups. These resources include a social media messaging calendar, shareable graphics, web banners, posters, sample public service announcements and more. In addition, visitors can take an online stalking quiz, complete an online course on the use of technology to stalk or watch Stalking: Real Fear, Real Crime.
