15-Minute Child Break Program

The Department of Human Resources is pleased to host the Partnership for a Drug-Free New Jersey's (PDFNJ) 15-Minute Child Break program on Thursday, February 23. There will be two sessions: 2 – 2.45 p.m., and 3.30 – 4.15 p.m., both taking place in the Learning Resource Center, Room 122.

The Child Break presentation will be a 45-minute program that empowers and encourages parents and other adult caregivers to effectively communicate with children and adolescents about the misuse and abuse of alcohol and other drugs. The presentation includes statistics and public service announcements about alcohol and other drugs. Specific emphasis is given to underage drinking, marijuana use and the current opioid/heroin crisis taking place throughout the state. Specific prevention strategies are also provided.

A discussion on the issue of college drinking and drug use will also take place.
