CCM Nursing Department Engages in Community Work



CCM Professors Buffy Reilly and Therese Farmer, along with 12 CCM students from the Nursing department and two medical students, attended a service trip with Experience Mission to Gary, WV, located in McDowell County. The purpose of the journey was to enhance

student learning about health effects in an environment of extreme poverty.

Activities consisted of demolition, construction, leveling, mulching and installing drainage pipes for a playground, visiting a nursing home, planting flowers and interacting with the community. The CCM students who were in attendance stated that the experience was invaluable and they are interested in going again. Students who did not know one another before the trip bonded and learned to problem-solve and overcome challenges. The students returned from the trip stronger with a greater sense of physical, emotional and spiritual accomplishment.

CCM faculty intend to continue engagement with the community and conduct future student trips. Contacts have been made within the community which will allow for a continued relationship between CCM and the School for Life in Gary. The students are planning a backpack drive, for the kids of the community, to be delivered in September.
