CCM Student Athletes Receive National Distinction



The National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) has recognized eight CCM Titan student athletes for their educational achievements during the 2016-17 academic year.

A total of five CCM student athletes were named to the NJCAA Second Team for obtaining a grade point average of 3.80 to 3.99. Those students are Matias Lago of

Randolph (Soccer), Mark Lalo of Denville (Soccer), Jaida Schettino of Sparta (Soccer), Jonathan Svendsen of Great Meadows (Soccer), and Stephanie Williams of Roxbury (Soccer).

Three CCM student athletes were named to the NJCAA Third Team for obtaining a grade point average of 3.6 to 3.79. They are JanCarlo Figueroa of Rockaway (Lacrosse), Taylor McQuade of West Milford (Soccer), and Christen Mills of Whippany (Softball).

Pension Contribution Rate Change for PERS

Pursuant to Chapter 78, P.L. 2011, Pension and Benefit Reform, Public Employees Retirement System (PERS) employee contribution rates will increase from 7.2 percent to 7.34 percent of salary with the first paycheck issued after July 1.
