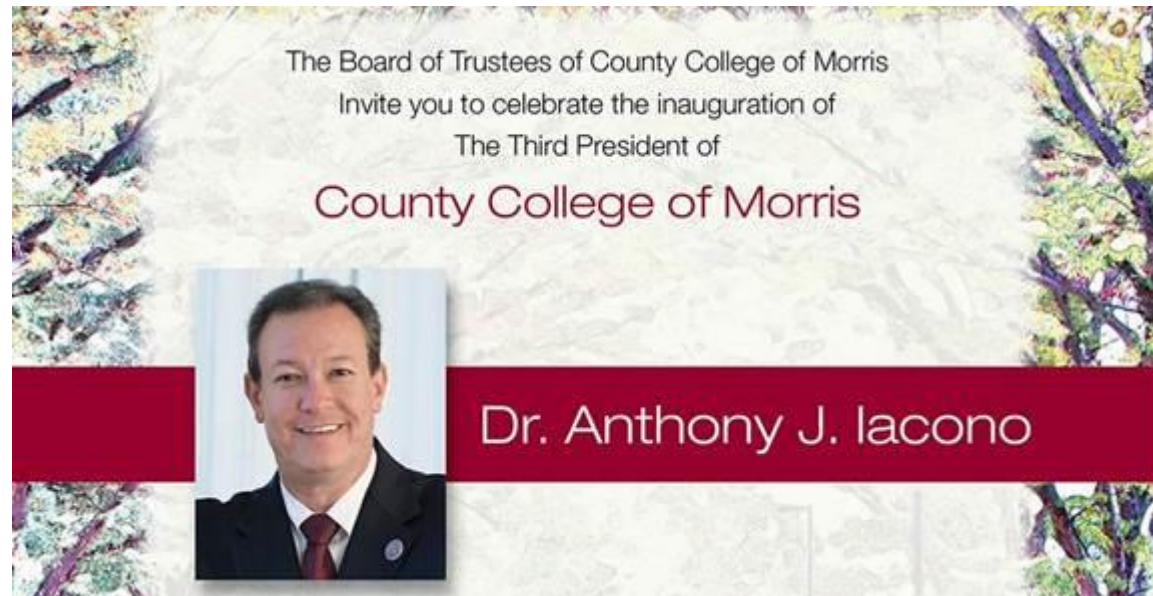




CCM Presidential Inauguration Events
