ENROLLMENT REPORT

Creating a Culture Steeped in Data

As CCM begins building a culture of evidence steeped in the use of data for decision making, Institutional Research (IR) is pleased to share an updated Enrollment Comparison Report. This report – for internal audiences – replaces the PowerPoint slides previously provided by the Registrar's office. The new report provides the same data and information but is automatically generated instead of being manually calculated and entered.

The report is a temporary addition until a Data Warehouse for Business Intelligence (DW/BI) is built for the college. Once built, the DW/BI enrollment reports will offer drilldown options into more granular data details, trend lines and allow for more in-depth analysis.

The college's Enrollment and Retention Committee has moved CCM from years of decline in enrollments to several semesters of increased enrollment, utilizing data. This updated report is scheduled to run daily and will be distributed to every Administration Council member as well as department chairs. All CCM employees, however, can access the Enrollment Comparison reports at <F:\groups\All CCM\Daily Enrollment Comparison>.
