DANCE THEATRE SHOWCASE

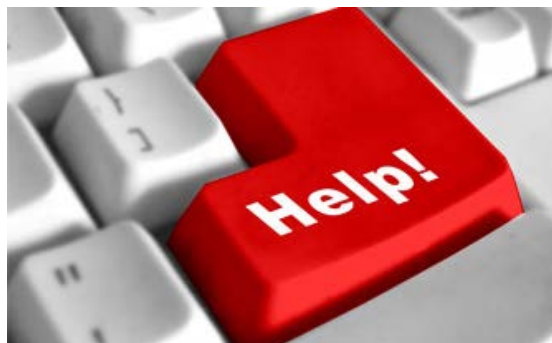

HELP DESK TRANSITIONS TO SOLUTIONS CENTER ON APRIL 2

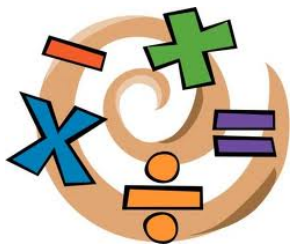
