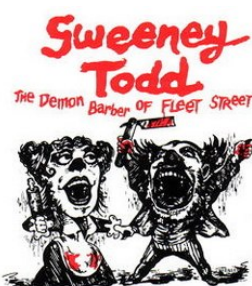

## HEALTH PLAN OPEN ENROLLMENT FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2019

Open enrollment for full-time, benefit eligible employees will begin on October 1 and will end on October 31. Employees can make general changes (such as adding or deleting dependents, changing coverage levels, etc.) or enroll in a different medical plan. All changes made during open enrollment will be effective January 1, 2019.
