IMPORTANT HEALTH BENEFITS DEPENDENT ELIGIBILITY AUDIT

Employees who are actively enrolled in the School Employees Health Benefit Program (SEHBP) who cover their spouse, domestic partner and/or children recently received a mailing from the New Jersey Division of Pensions and Benefits (NJDPB) of an upcoming Dependent Eligibility Verification Audit (DEVA).

Those employees will be contacted by Alight, the company the NJDPB has retained to complete this audit. You will be required to provide copies of documentation to prove your dependents are still eligible for coverage under the SEHBP. If you are married you must provide a copy of your marriage certificate AND the first page of the most recently filed 1040 federal tax return; if you have a domestic partnership, you must provide a copy of your partnership certificate and the first page of the most recently filed 1040 federal tax return; if you cover children, you must provide a copy of the child's birth certificate, adoption papers, etc.

Check your mail for the information from Alight. It is your responsibility to provide the required documentation; if you do not, your dependent coverage will be terminated.
