In response to the number of requests being submitted for student aides, please remember that students who receive work-study as part of their financial aid must be given hiring priority, regardless of the availability of departmental funds. This does not apply to students being rehired. It is important that CCM expends its federal work-study funds to the fullest extent possible.

On August 5, an email was sent to 1,200 work-study students advising them of their eligibility and the availability of on-campus jobs. In order to give those students the opportunity to pursue on-campus employment, we will wait until September 11 to hire non-work-study students.
