	Submit your transcripts from any other college or colleges you may have attended.
	Consider submitting your SAT/ACT scores. At CCM, this is optional but may exempt you from placement testing.
	We encourage you to submit your Admissions application and other documents several months before the start of a semester so you can register early and get the best choice of classes.
