By Law, all F-1 nonimmigrant students are required to document that they have sufficient funds to cover tuition and expenses during their duration of study at CCM. The I 20 AB will be issued following the submission of the required supporting financial documents.

- All financial support documentation must be official, original and notarized. Photocopies and faxes are not acceptable
- All documentation must be dated within 6 months of the CCM enrollment date
- Funds should be liquid assets i.e. cash in a savings, checking or money market account in a United Savings Bank
