

www.ccm.edu. Many courses do not have prerequisites. However, English, math and most science courses do and placement testing is required, i.e., Accuplacer Test, College Level Math (CLM) Test. When this applies, please refer to your admissions email and letter for your *Student Identification #* and contact the Testing Center, 973-328-5166, to schedule the necessary test; be sure to ask about sample questions.

Students with the following SAT/ACT scores, or higher, are exempt from the corresponding part of the Accuplacer Test:

- New SAT *Evidence Based Reading & Writing* 590 or ACT *English* 23 – exempt from the English portion of Accuplacer
- New SAT *Math* 560 or ACT *Math* 23 – exempt from the Math/Algebra portion of Accuplacer

If applicable, please include an unofficial copy of the test scores with your *Challenger Program Application*. Additional information about exemptions is available at www.ccm.edu/testing.

- 3) Be sure to note that some *advanced courses* require additional assessment testing, department waivers or preliminary course completion before registration.
- 4) Students who are *age 15 or younger* must have their Challenger Registration forms signed by the appropriate CCM Academic Deans or Department Chairpersons. Please plan to fulfill this provision early by contacting:

- 5) Registering for a course(s) must be done **in-person** only. Please bring the completed *Challenger Registration Form* with all requisite signatures to the *Office of Records and Registration* in the Student Community Center, Parking Lot 6. *Tuition bills* may then be paid next door at the *Bursar's office*. To view the *Payment Due Date*, please go to the *WebAdvisor* link in the *Quicklinks* box, www.ccm.edu.
- 6) Lastly, it is strongly advisable to identify *alternate choices* on the Challenger Registration Form. Please be aware that *extra fees* are assessed for late payment and withdrawal.

Please note that enrollment in remedial/developmental English, mathematics and ESL (English for Speakers of Other Languages) is not permitted, despite placement test results.

Application and Course Registration Procedures

1) All *first-time* students who are new to the Challenger Program must submit the completed *Challenger Application* and application fee to the CCM Admissions office. Students who have a Permanent Residency Card or a Visa are required to bring their original document to the Admissions office; copies are not acceptable. Upon receipt of these materials, students will receive a confirmation email and letter containing their *Student Identification #*. (Continuing students are exempt from reapplying and need only follow the registration procedures.)
