The AAPT is appropriate for students who:

- Scored 560 or higher on the Math SAT, 23 or higher on the Math ACT or 4 or 5 on Algebra 2 PARCC/NJSLA.
- Scored 250 - 275 on the Next Gen QAS or 63-75 on the Classic Algebra and submitted a Math SAT of 550, 540, or 530.
- Completed the equivalent Introductory and Intermediate Algebra developmental courses at another regionally accredited college or university.
- You may retake the Accuplacer Math test one additional time, one week, after your original test. The fee for retaking the test is \$10.00.
