

MATH - STANDARDIZED PLACEMENT TESTS

(Exemptions from non- credit/developmental Math courses)

Students are exempt from the Math placement test and/or High School Transcript evaluation if the minimum SAT, ACT, or PARCC/NJSLA scores were met.

- **SAT** – 560 or higher
- **ACT** – 23 or higher
- **Algebra 2 PARCC/NJSLA** - 4 or 5
