## **Downloading and Installing Certificates (Android)**


Installing certificates will secure your network traffic.

1. Open up a browser (Chrome, Samsung Internet Browser, etc.).



- 2. Go to the Self Service Portal:
  - a. *If you are a CCM Student:* Go to <a href="https://www.ccm.edu/ccm-self-service-portal/student-self-service-portal/">https://www.ccm.edu/ccm-self-service-portal/student-self-service-portal/</a>
  - b. *If you are a CCM faculty of staff member:* Go to <a href="https://www.ccm.edu/ccm-self-service-portal/faculty-staff-service-portal/">https://www.ccm.edu/ccm-self-service-portal/</a>
- 3. Scroll down to the "Accessing CCM-Wireless" section and tap the Certificate link.



4. The certificate will start to download. When done, tap Open on the downloaded certificate.



- 5. If Open is an option, skip to step 9. If not, step 6-8 shows you how to find the certificate.
- 6. Install the certificate by navigating to your "File Manager". Below is an example for an LG phone.



7. Look for and tap the Download folder.






8. Click on the certificate to install. The file will end in .crt.



- 9. Your device will prompt you to authenticate with a pattern, pin, password, etc. If this is not set up already, you will need to setup some type of authentication.
- 10. After authenticating, you will need to name and choose the credential use for the certificate.



11. Name the certificate CCM-Wireless. Make sure you choose Wireless for "Credential use".



- 12. Tap OK.
- 13. Go back to Wi-Fi settings and continue from step 4 on <u>Connecting to CCM-Wireless (Android)</u> instructions.
