
CCM-Wireless is a secured network for CCM students, faculty, and staff. To easily connect to CCM-Wireless, please follow these steps:


1. Click on the drop down arrow on top right of your screen.



2. Click on the drop down arrow next to Wi-Fi Not Connected.




3. A network selection window will pop up. Select CCM-GUEST and click connect.




4. Open up a browser and type in any site name (yahoo.com, cnn.com, msn.com) and click enter.




5. Click Open Network Login Page.



6. Scroll down to bottom of the CCM Self-Registration page and click RootCert.




7. Click OK to save the file.




8. Click on the drop down arrow on top right of your screen again.




9. Click on the drop down arrow next to Wi-Fi Not Connected again.




10. The network selection window will pop up. Select CCM-Wireless this time and click connect.




- 11. A box should pop up to make selections and enter your Username and Password.
  - a. Make sure Protected EAP (PEAP) is selected for Authentication
  - b. Click the drop down to Select from file... for CA certificate




12. Find the certificate that was downloaded from the CCM Self-Registration page, step 6, and Select it. The certificate should be in the Downloads folder.



- 13. Enter your Username and Password. Make sure MSCHAPv2 is selected for Inner authentication.
  - a. *If you are a CCM Student:* Enter your WebAdvisor/Titans Direct Username and Password. Click OK when done.
  - b. If you are a CCM faculty or staff: Enter your network Username and Password. Click OK.



14. You are now connected to CCM-Wireless. You may want to forget the CCM-GUEST network. This can be done repeating steps 1 and 2, then selecting the gear icon next to CCM-GUEST.



15. Click Forget Connection.
