- 4. I have a minimum cumulative grade point average at CCM of 2.5. All grades are a "C" or better and the sciences have been completed during the past seven years.

I acknowledge that due to the competitive nature of admission to the Nursing Program, granting a seat in NUR-121 is based on the number of courses completed at CCM, the grades received in sciences and English and the overall institutional GPA at the time the application form is filed. Filing this form and completing the above steps does not guarantee enrollment in NUR-121.
6. I understand that all students enrolled in the professional phase will be required to submit to a Criminal History Background Check (CHBC) and Drug Test Screening as mandated by our clinical partners. The Criminal History Background Check will occur on an annual basis. If the background check yields a positive result, admission into the professional phase of the program may be denied. If at any time after acceptance into the professional phase of the program a student has a positive criminal history background record, it may result in dismissal from the program.

Due to availability of clinical sites and experiences, clinical schedules may vary. For example, a student in the Day or Evening Track may be required to attend a clinical experience from 1:00pm to 9:00pm or 7:00am to 7:00pm.
