What is DCP?

The Dover College Promise (DCP) is a grant funded educational partnership between County College of Morris (CCM), The Educational Center (TEC) Inc. and the Dover School District to offer motivated low-income middle and high school students with the opportunity to secure a college path.



Benefits of DCP

- Educational workshops designed for college
 - › Preparation and success in career exploration, college onboarding process, cultural education, communication and financial planning
- Personalized CCM educational/college plan
- Tutoring services
- Student field trips
- Student community-based service projects
- Counseling sessions and academic monitoring
- Assistance with CCM college forms, admission application and other college related processes
 - › Students have a personal advocate
- CCM college student success class
- CCM Foundation scholarship to cover tuition for up to 2 years
