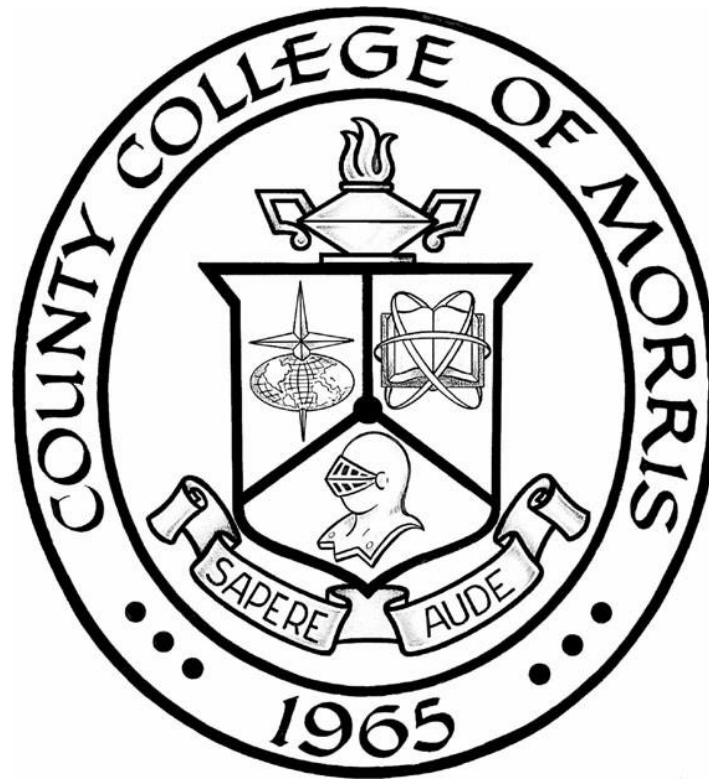


College Seal



The *Lamp of Learning* cresting the shield represents the paramount purpose of the institution, while the *Polaris* and *Globe* represent the guiding role which education plays in the world.

The *Atomic Symbol* generally portrays the age in which we live, made possible by the accumulation of knowledge as represented by the volume. The orbits of the atomic symbol further represent the three basic objectives of the college in the education of the student: intellectual, personal, and social.

The *Knight's Helmet* is excerpted from the official seal of the County of Morris and symbolizes the sponsorship of the college by the County.

The three dividers on each side of the founding date represent the fact that New Jersey was the third of the original thirteen states.

Finally, the motto, "Sapere Aude," translated into English, means "Dare to Know" and is a charge and a challenge to all those who would better themselves through education.
