COUNTY COLLEGE OF MORRIS BOARD OF TRUSTEES MINUTES REGULAR MEETING VIA TELECONFERENCE

March 24, 2020

CALL TO ORDER

Board of Trustees Chair Thomas A. Pepe called the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the County College of Morris to order at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was held using a teleconference format. Chair Pepe stated that in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act of the State of New Jersey, adequate notice of the revised format of this Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees was provided on March 19, 2020. Advance written notice of this meeting was posted on the County College of Morris webpage, was sent to the Star Ledger and Daily Record, and was filed with the Clerk of the County of Morris.

ROLL CALL

Trustees Advokat, Allen-McMillan, Aprile, Dredden, Frost, Hadzima, Licitra, Weisberg, and Chair Pepe were in attendance. Alumni Trustee Otero Lopez, President Iacono, and Attorney Schneider were also in attendance.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chair Pepe invited everyone to rise and salute the flag. Everyone rose, saluted the flag and recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Following the flag salute, Trustee Licitra led the Board of Trustees and others on the teleconference in a moment of silence.

Attorney Schneider addressed the attendees by stating that the teleconference is being conducted in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act. The New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (DCA) provided guidance for conducting public meetings electronically. Following the guidance of the DCA the Board of Trustees will not conduct business in a session closed to the public. Members of the public will still be afforded the opportunity to provide comments to the Board of Trustees. The Notice of this meeting in the revised format was provided as required.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Chair Pepe called for consideration of the minutes of the regular meeting of February 25, 2020, including the closed session, and the special meeting of March 10, 2020, including the closed session. Upon the motion of Trustee Licitra and the second of Trustee Hadzima, Chair Pepe called for a voice vote of the Board. The voice vote of the Board indicated that all present were in favor of the minutes as distributed.

REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT

President Iacono referred the Board to the written Report of the President that is on file in the Office of the President. President Iacono also reviewed the preparations responding to the COVID-19 outbreak which began three weeks ago, including infectious disease policies which gained national attention; daily updates with the Emergency Management Team; regularly communicating with and hearing from employees, faculty, students, bargaining unit presidents; establishing a COVID-19 Information and Resource Center web page; and creating TASC+ online resource center.

Trustee Milonas inquired about the COVID-19 testing site being set up on the college campus. President Iacono responded that the site is still being set up and awaiting the necessary supplies. It is expected that the site will be operational by the end of this week.

On behalf of Committee Chair Licitra, Trustee Advokat moved for the adoption of the following resolutions.

WHEREAS, The estimated cost of repairs and renovations including Building Modifications, Accessibility, Water Penetration; Roads, Walkways and Parking Lots; and Exterior Facilities (the "Project") is \$5,240,000 (of the amount so estimated, the sum of \$2,620,000 is to be provided pursuant to Chapter 12 of the Laws of 1971);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That pursuant to NJSA 18A:64A-19(1), the Board of Trustees of the County College of Morris deems it necessary to raise money for the Project.

The amount of the estimated cost and the estimated amount of money needed for such purposes is \$5,240,000 (of which \$2,620,000 is expected to be provided pursuant to Chapter 12 of the Laws of 1971). The Statement of Estimated Cost of the Project, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby adopted by the Board of Trustees. It is proposed to the Board of School Estimate that \$5,240,000 or an amount equal to the Chapter 12 funding, whichever is less, shall be raised by the County of Morris by bond ordinance or other means authorized by law.

Trustee Licitra seconded the motion. Chair Pepe called for discussion by members of the Board. There being no questions or comments, Chair Pepe called for a roll call vote of the Board. The roll call vote of the Board indicated that all were in favor.

B. WHEREAS, The estimated cost of the HVAC, Roads, Walkways, and Parking Lot Improvements (the "Project") is \$630,000;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That pursuant to NJSA 18A:64A-10(1), the Board of Trustees of the County College of Morris deems it necessary to raise money for the Project.

The amount of the estimated cost and the estimated amount of money needed for such purposes is \$630,000. The Statement of Estimated Cost of the Project, attached hereto as Exhibit B, is hereby adopted by the Board of Trustees. It is proposed to the Board of School Estimate that \$630,000 shall be raised by the County of Morris by bond ordinance or other means authorized by law.

The Secretary of this Board of Trustees shall mail a certified copy of this resolution to the members of the Board of School Estimate. Upon receipt of this statement, the Board of School Estimate shall, at a specified public meeting called and noticed pursuant to law, fix and determine the sum of money needed for the purposes specified in this statement and the amount to be raised by the County of Morris.

Trustee Hadzima seconded the motion. Chair Pepe called for discussion by members of the Board. There being no questions or comments, Chair Pepe called for a roll call vote of the Board. The roll call vote of the Board indicated that all were in favor. The Report of the Committee on Lands and Buildings was concluded.

MATTERS TO BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE BOARD BY OFFICERS OF THE BOARD

Chair Pepe and Trustee Advokat each expressed gratitude on behalf of the Board for tremendous efforts, hard work, and leadership as the college prepared an operational response to the COVID-19 outbreak.

WHEREAS, the County College of Morris ("College") needs to acquire professional services for the Student Success Analytics Admissions-Recruiter module migration to the SAP cloud; and

WHEREAS, the purchasing agent has determined and certified in writing that the value of the full term of the contract for the above goods or services is \$32,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated term of this contract is March 25, 2020 – June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of a publicly advertised solicitation of proposals, the College has precluded from consideration for the contract award, any contractor who is ineligible under N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 by reason of a reportable political contribution; and

WHEREAS, ASR Analytics ("Contractor") has submitted a proposal dated March 3, 2020 indicating that Contractor will provide professional services for the Student Success Analytics Admissions-Recruiter module migration to the SAP cloud for a value of \$32,500.00; and

WHEREAS, Contractor has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that Contractor has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee representing an elected official of the County of Morris in the previous one year, and Contractor has agreed to contract language prohibiting Contractor from making such reportable contributions during the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, Contractor has completed and submitted ten days in advance of adoption of this resolution, a Chapter 271 Political Contribution Disclosure form which will be placed on file with this resolution; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available to pay for the aforesaid services or goods;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the County College of Morris authorizes the College to enter into a contract with the above identified Contractor as stated; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Business Disclosure Entity Certification and the Determination of Estimated Value be placed on file with this resolution.
